## **MINUTES**

**16/03/2 Guest Speaker(s).** Jon Stewart, General Manager, Peak District. National Trust gave an informative and interesting update of the National Trust activities in the area and the Council thanked him for his time.

They also put forward a proposal requesting if the Council would consider paying the annual maintenance cost. The Council agreed to pay the cost for the first year of £126.00 and suggested that a request is brought to the council each year.
