MINUTES

16/10/1 Apologies for absence. Cllr. Julie Morten (Accepted). HPBC Cllr. Jim Perkins.

16/10/2 Guest Speaker(s). None

16/10/3 Declarations of interests. None

16/10/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.

A member of the public from Hope informed the Parish Council that due to a high number of thefts in the Hope Valley he has been looking into the possibility of installing an Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) System in the surrounding area. The purpose of this would be to not only deter criminals but to help track vehicles used in crimes. He will be speaking to other Parish Councils in the Hope Valley and although he doesn't need permission or funding he would like the Parish council's backing. It was agreed in principal that it was a good idea, however the Clerk was asked to contact the Police for their opinion.

A letter was tabled from a member of the public regarding the use of the Charities Car Park and with regard to hedge cutting in Grindsbrook Booth.

HPBC Cllr. Helliwell stated there had been an unprecedented response with regards to the planned closure at Newholme Hospital and others. There is concern about the level of policing in the Hope Valley. The Council thanked Cllr. Helliwell for all her efforts.
