**17/02/1 Apologies for absence.** None

**17/02/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.** An email was received from the Police stating there have been 2 crimes reported in Edale, a shed break in and a vehicle rear window smashed. However, it has also been reported that Chapel and Whaley Bridge have had a lot of burglaries over the last month. The public are advised to make sure that everything is as secure as they can.  
An email has been received stating the ANPR camera system is progressing. The Parish Council restated their support and await developments.
