**17/11/1 Apologies for absence.** DCC Councillor Jim Perkins, HPBC Councillor Sarah Helliwell

**17/11/2 Guest Speaker.** None.

**17/11/3 Declarations of interests.** Cllr. Tennant declared an interest in item 17/11/7.2.

**17/11/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.** There were no members of the public present.

**17/11/5 Minutes of previous meetings.** Minutes for the Regular Meeting of 11<sup>th</sup> October 2017 were proposed for adoption as a true representation of the meeting by Cllr. Gilbert, seconded by Cllr. Tennant and signed by Cllr. Favell.

**17/11/6 Chairman's announcements** (Not for discussion)

- Communication has been received that planning permission was not required for the Football Club changing room.
- An updated plan has been received from Friends of Edale Station. A meeting is planned with Northern Rail on the 12<sup>th</sup> December.
- There has been no progress re the ANPR system in the Valley, the Chief Inspector has not yet reported back as to the involvement level of the Police.

**17/11/7 Report on matters arising from the minutes (unless noted for discussion later in the meeting).**

17/11/7.1 Parish Council Archives. The Clerk reported that the records office in Matlock do not have the Parish Council Minute books from 1969 to 1990. A notice to be put in Ringing Roger.

17/11/7.2 Village Benches and Parish Notice Boards maintenance tender. Cllr. Tennant took no part in this discussion. A tender from the Peak Centre has been received and approved for £595 plus materials.

17/11/7.3 Edale Twinning with Yetholm and Edale road signs. The Clerk reported that a request has been sent to highways to change the proposed wording on the village signs.

17/11/7.4 General Data Protection Regulation. It was agreed to delay this item until March/April 2018 when implications of the new GDPR will be better known.

17/11/7.5 Policy for engaging with the planning system. A "Councillors workbook on planning" has been received and is to be circulated to Councillors. This item to be taken forward to the next meeting.
