MINUTES

17/12/1 Apologies for absence. Cllr. Don Tennant (accepted); DCC Cllr. Jim Perkins.

17/12/2 Guest Speaker. Phil Rogers updated the Council on the progress of the Friends of Edale Station group. They had a progressive meeting with Northern Rail with representatives from Moors for the Future, National Park Authority and the Parish Council. Some funding is available which will allow the immediate advancement of the project with further ideas on future progress also involving the School. There is a possibility of “special event” rail tickets to promote events in Edale travelling by rail so reducing road congestion.
