MINUTES

Present: Councillors: Tony Favell (Chairman); Julie Morten; Rosie Rumble; Cedric Gilbert; Don Tennant; Clerk: Nick Faulks; DCC Councillor Jim Perkins; PSCO Steve Rogers and 12 members of the public.

This meeting was open to the public unless otherwise stated.

It was approved that Chairman's Announcement would be moved to precede Public Speaking.

18/01/1 Apologies for absence. HPBC Councillor Sarah Helliwell.

18/01/2 Guest Speaker. None.

18/01/3 Declarations of interests. Cllr. Favell item 18/01/9.1. Cllr. Rumble item 18/01/9.1.

18/01/6 Chairman's announcements (Not for discussion)

- The Chairman stated an email had been received from a member of the public with regard to Cycling in the Parish. This will be put on the agenda for the next meeting.
- The Chairman also gave a synopsis of a meeting held earlier in the day with DCC Highways with regard to parking outside the Church. An option to make this area a maximum stay of 90 minutes is to be investigated. It was stated that Police will only get involved with obstruction if you cannot get out of your driveway but not if you cannot get in. This is to be verified by the PCSO. The Vicar is to talk to the PCC.

18/01/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.

The Chairman invited each person present to speak on the subject of parking problems in the village.

The following items, among others, were raised:

- There are different issues in different parts of the village but are all related to busy times such as sunny weekends and bank holidays.
- Safety was of great concern.
- Concern expressed about the bottom end of Ollerbrook Lane
- Concerns that any actions would deter tourism.
- Concern that the infrastructure is not keeping pace with increase in tourism.
- Modernise the parking payment machines to allow card payments
- On busy days to have other venues for car parking
- Allow free parking in the village between 7:00 and 9:00 then to charge.
- To make the area outside the Church a drop off only.
- Special arrangements for special events
- Traffic wardens to be more prevalent (but would not differentiate between tourist and villagers).
- There have been a number of minor accidents in Grindsbrook and safety is an issue
- To have "No Parking" and "Residents Only" signs
- It was suggested by a number of speakers that a subcommittee be formed to investigate in depth all the issues and possible solutions

Mr P McIntyre spoke on the recent address to the village by PCSO Steve Rogers. He stated that 60packs of Smartwater have been ordered and distributed and 66% of the Parish is now covered. He requested the support of the Council to put up street signs around the village and to raise public awareness in the form of an advertising campaign. See item 18/01/8.1 for Council discussion.

18/01/6 Chairman's announcements. Moved to precede public speaking.

18/01/5 Minutes of previous meetings.

Minutes for the Regular Meeting of 13th December 2017 were proposed for adoption as a true representation of the meeting by Cllr. Gilbert, seconded by Cllr. Rumble and signed by Cllr. Favell.

18/01/7 Report on matters arising from the minutes (unless noted for discussion later in the meeting).

18/01/7.1 Parish Council Archives to be carried forward to the next meeting.

18/01/7.2 Village Benches and Parish Notice Boards maintenance tender. Good progress being made to both noticeboards and benches.

18/01/7.3 Edale Twinning with Yetholm and Edale road signs. Following a meeting with highways the location of the east side village sign has been agreed. The design and wording of the twinning signs was approved. A budget of up to £500 was approved by the Council to be taken from the Village Project fund.

18/01/7.4 WW1 Beacons tribute of light 11 November 2018. The beacon is to be purchased by the Clerk. DCC Councillor Perkins indicated that additional funds were available from DCC for the shortfall in the cost of the beacon.

18/01/7.5 Grass cutting contracts 2018-2020. The Clerk reported that the invitation to tender has been posted on the internet and noticeboards.

18/01/8 Items for discussion/ decision.

18/01/8.1 Smartwater: Signs and Press Article. Following the presentation in public speaking, the Council agreed that this would be advantageous. Permission would be required from DCC Highways to put signs up and the Council offer Mr McIntyre their full support in his application. The Council agree to the suggested positioning of any signs but would also suggest one be erected in each of the booths. The Council agreed to purchase 8 of the plastic signs. The Council agreed for Mr McIntyre to progress this on behalf of the village and suggest that he asks the PCSO for his assistance in the application and advertising campaign.

18/01/8.2 Parish Council grit. It was agreed that grit will be made available to the compound by the village hall, to the Station and to all the Booths as necessary. Cllr. Rumble to contact Mr Wainwright for permission at Ollerbrook.

18/01/8.3 Derbyshire County Council Local List consultation. Noted.
