MINUTES

Present: Councillors: Julie Morten (Chair); Tony Favell; Cedric Gilbert; Morgan Jackson; Rosie Rumble; DCC Councillor Jim Perkins; Nick Faulks and five members of the public.

This meeting was open to the public unless otherwise stated.

18/10/1 Apologies for absence. HPBC Councillor Sarah Helliwell.

18/10/2 Guest Speaker. None.

18/10/3 Declarations of interests. None.

18/10/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.

- A member of the public raised concerns re Mam Nick road closure on 20/10/18. A letter of complaint to be written regarding the lack of consultation and the disruption it will cause.
- Simon Cocksedge reported that for the WWI Commemoration there will be a service in the Church, there will also be a display by the School. The bells are to be rung at 7:05PM (this is a national event). No changes are to be made to the Memorial. The Parish Council are arranging for a beacon to be lit at 7:00PM (this is also a national event).
- Simon Cocksedge also reported that he had visited Kirk Yetholm. They are impressed with the “twinning” sign. There are a number of organisations that wish to link up in the two communities.
- DCC Cllr. Jim Perkins reported that DCC are no longer contracted by HPBC for lighting repairs. The issue of the light outside Lanehead Green and in Edale Car Park is to be passed back to HPBC. Cllr. Perkins also reported that highways are intending to make changes to road markings on the road going up to Grindsbrook, to allow an extra parking space outside the school, and to modify the parking outside the Church. However any modifications will be brought to the Parish Council for consultation before they are made.
- A member of the Edale Parking Group presented to the Council the 10 ideas to improve parking in Edale (a synopsis of these ideas can be seen in the October Edition of the Ringing Roger). The Council agreed to take this document under review. DCC Cllr. Perkins agreed to seek advice on the option to standardise the speed limit up to Barber Booth and he also agreed to arrange for a highways representative to meet with the Council to discuss issues and possible solutions. The Council agreed to invite a representative of the Edale Parking Group to give a 10 minute presentation on “Pedestrianisation of the road up to Grindsbrook”.

18/10/5 Minutes of previous meetings. Minutes for the Regular Meeting of 12th September 2018 were proposed for adoption as a true representation of the meeting by Cllr. Gilbert, seconded by Cllr. Favell, adopted, and signed by Cllr. Morten.

18/10/6 Chairman’s announcements (Not for discussion)

- The times for the Public Library to visit Edale are Thursdays the 18th October, 15th November and 13th December from 2:05PM to 2:35PM in the car park.

18/10/7.2 WW1 Commemoration 11/11/18. The Lamp post Poppies have been delivered. The Silhouette is on order and the Clerk has applied to HPBC for a licence. The Beacon has been delivered and the Clerk authorised to purchase gas canisters. The National Trust is to be contacted to assist in the siting of the beacon which is hoped to be Lords Seat. The Beacon will be lit at 7:00PM on the 11th November 2018.
