MINUTES

19/01/1 Apologies for absence. HPBC Cllr. Sarah Helliwell; PC Graham Mason

19/01/2 Guest Speaker. None.

19/01/3 Declarations of interests. None.

19/01/4 Public speaking – max 10 min.

DCC Councillor Perkins stated that highways are starting to put up / relocate signage for the car park and pedestrians. New time plates are to be erected outside the Church ready for single yellow lines and restricted parking (2 hours) as soon as the TRO (Traffic regulation order) is in effect. Outside the school, it is expected that proper parking bays are to be marked and signage erected. Village only signs are to be considered.

19/01/5 Minutes of previous meetings. Minutes for the Regular Meeting 12th December 2018 were proposed for adoption as a true representation of the meeting by Cllr. Gilbert, seconded by Cllr. Jackson, adopted, and signed by Cllr. Morten.

19/01/9.1 NP/HPK/0818/0707. 4 Water Meadows Hope Road Edale. Removal of existing rear lounge window and replacement by outward opening bifold doors. Granted. Noted.

19/01/9.2 NP/HPK/1118/1037. Lower Hollins Farm Hope Road Edale. Conversion of a barn for use as stables, hardstanding and construction of a railway sleeper bridge. Pending. Noted.

19/01/9.3 NP/HPK/1218/1208. Holy Trinity Church Unnamed Road from Hope Road. Extension to provide toilet and alterations to porch to create disabled access. The Council is in support of this application.

If the Peak Park Planning Officer is minded to refuse this application under their delegated power, Cllr. Favell, as the elected Parish Council Representative at the Peak Park Authority, has requested that it be taken to committee where the public are able to make representation.

There has been one minor increase in the precept over the last 11 years and the current increase is required to ensure the Council remains sustainable in the future.
