MINUTES

21/02/1 Apologies for absence. Cllr. Gilbert (accepted); Cllr. Gould (accepted).

21/02/2 Declarations of interests. None.

21/02/3 Public speaking – max 10 min.

- DCC Cllr. Perkins stated that due to the extraordinary weather conditions gritting will prioritise “A” roads and primary roads.

21/02/6 Report on matters arising from the minutes (unless noted for discussion later in the meeting)

- 21/02/6.1 Tipps car park and the road to Upper Booth. This was discussed by DCC highways and PDNPA at a recent meeting. Yellow lines on the road to Upper Booth would be impractical due to the condition of the road surface, and would become unenforceable. Experience elsewhere shows that Clearways are limited in their success (refer Ladybower). Charging for the car park is an option, but likely to worsen the situation. Preliminary thought has been given by PDNPA to additional parking spaces either by expanding the car park, or through the 28 (56) day rule.
- 21/02/6.2 Council Archives. The Clerk stated he had contacted the records office and advised them that the Parish Council wished to deposit minutes for archiving. The office is currently closed due to covid restrictions. This will be passed on to the new clerk.
